FEC and CAPT jointly move to insert the following text (italic type) into the Faculty Handbook, Part One, Article VI, Section A. (Tenure-Track Faculty), under Community Service (page 107):

Participation in faculty governance is another important option requiring skills and commitment that answer the needs of the College. *In particular, and especially as it pertains to faculty with tenure, it should be noted that service in the seven core governance committees is critical to maintaining the shared-governance system that is central to the College's institutional identity. Those seven committees are the Committee on Academic Freedom and Rights [CAFR]*
