F. FACULTY GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

1. THE SERVICE CYCLE

Skidmore faculty is expected to partictpetEairulty governance committees whose functions are the ultimate responsibility of the (facultynure, promotion, curriculum, academic standards, and academic freedom). These committees of the faculty are currently listed i Two, Section II F 1-16. The Service Cycle establishation structure primarily for service on these committees and orPPIGE for all-college committees, ad hoc committees, working groups, task forces, or student government committees, the Faculty Executive Committee appoint faculty from the ad hoc pool accommittee and hoc pool is constituted by faculty who are in their service cycle but not serving on a committee and by junior faculties record or third year.

The cycle establishes a college-wide seventaytian cycle for faculty governance service. FEC fosters communication within the Faaultoythvireports to the Faculty Meeting and organization of other facultoyusdion meetings and foradoosut all-College issues and policies. The Chair of FEC shall sit on IPBCdim to strengthemmonication between the two committees. FEC, together with IPRCA aisdresponsible for the proper constitution of all-College committees and subcommittees.

FEC is responsible for coordinating faculty ittee work and for furthering democratic representation and committee efficiency. §§6nisible for ensuring the proper constitution of faculty committeessolicits nominations for, condections for, and makes appointments to faculty and all-College committees; itspardvide and oversightproficedures regarding faculty appointments to search committees formiseistrative positions; and it maintains a list of all faculty memberallocommittees. Iddation, FEC reviews operating codes of all faculty committees and maintains files bcommittee reports, and FEC is responsible for ensuring that the text of the Faculty Handbook appears and remains precisely as approved Faculty.

Membership: Six faculty members, twoopf mutast be tenured, each from a different department, elected to serve three erms; the Dean of attuetly/Vice President for Academic Affairs or his/her designated attive; the Dean of Student Vice President for Student Affairs or his/her designated attive; and two students by SGA. CEPP may appoint such subcommittees from among its memberther Cooling communaity arge as it deems helpful to facilitate its work.

d. COMMITTEE ON ACADEMIC FREEDOM AND RIGHTS (CAFR) — Elected

Function: To serve as guardian of the acædelmin and rights of all members of the academic community; to receive inquiries and compositions and academic freedom and rights and to consider formal charges of violations ofica credentment and rights from any faculty member, student, administrator, trous feeting CAPT; to advise an demap propriate recommendations to the President. The Operating Proceduates after available find any member of the Committee. CAFR meets annually, whenever necessary ipultise of its functions, with the appropriate committee of the Board teets. Tree is in Part One of the Faculty Handbook, Articles I–XI, XIV-XVI, and XVIII areviewed by CAFR for its recommendations prior to a faculty vote.

f. FACULTY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (FDC) — Elected

Function: To advise the Dean of the Facelth/Asident for Academic Affairs on faculty development policies; to initiate ideas lftyrgfatowth and improvement, including programs to support both scholarly and professional activity/maprobvement of teaching; to allocate such research funds as the Dean of the Faculty/lient for Academic Affairs shall designate for committee decision; to represent the Faculty/ward of pre-tenure paid research and sabbatical leaves and to meakenmendations on such leaves to the Dean of the Faculty/Vice President for Academic Affairs; and etct state annual Edwin Moseley Faculty Research Lecturer, the recipient of The Ralph A. Ciancio Award for Excellence in Teaching, and the Distinguished Faculty Service Award.

m. FACULTY ADVISORY BOARD (F AB) - Elected and Appointed

Function: To provide a pool of faculty peerfs at a solvisory Panel (AP, see 15 below), which is convened in the formal investigation cifnand to or harassment charge made against a member of the Faculty; or to staff a GPlemeh (6P, see 16 below), which is convened (i) when a member of the Faculty applicability policy plant incompetence, neglect of duties, professional unit, or personal misconduct or (ii) when the Associate Dean of the Faculty for Person hephole ve, and Diversity believes dismissal of a member of the Faculty is material assed upon charges of spicon to incompetence, neglect of duties, professional misconduct, or personal misconduct

Membership: Eight members of the Facultysiaxtdearshom must be tenured and two of whom may be untenured at the time of appointenting to verlapping three-year terms. These members will be appointed by FEC in consultation Dean of Ranculty/Vice President for Academic Affairs, and tolonge Human Resources in mattreliscrimination, harassment, and disciplinary proceedings.
